I am a resident of [deleted] (previously named [deleted]) in [deleted], [deleted]. I and other residents have complained about crosses being placed by residents alongside walking paths which is against regulations. These complaints were made to Security Division; Public Relations and in writing to members of the [deleted] board. All complaints went unanswered.

This inaction by management of [deleted] resulted in an ugly anti-semetic incident on July 20 at approx. 6:45 pm. I was making my daily walk. A woman was spraying the lawn and saw me remove a cross that was placed underneath a street light (usually there are 50 to 70 crosses on a walking path of less than half a mile). She yelled something at me. I ignored it and continued walking. She followed me and when she caught up with me she shouted repeatedly: "You fucking jew; you'll burn in hell". I told her that she was insane and that I would report her to Security Division of [deleted] which I did. From the reaction I got I do not expect any kind of action. I was asked by the sergeant who made the report if I was jewish. In my opinion that is an irrelevant question and I told him so.

Yes I am jewish and I am also a concentration camp survivor and because of this experience I am taking this incident and the inaction of [deleted] management very serious. It is my hope that the anti-defamation league can look into this incident.

I do not know the name of the woman but her address is [deleted], [deleted], [deleted]. Her phone number is [deleted]. I am sure that [deleted] management can give you the name of the resident. My name is: [deleted], [deleted], [deleted]. Phone [deleted]

P.S. A few days ago an oriental couple watched me remove a couple of crosses. The lady came over to me and said: Thank you, we are afraid to do it and then in the oriental way she thanked me again. I believe this says a lot for a multi racial-ethnic community like [deleted].
